**STUDENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS & STUDENT CONTRACT**  
**2009- 2010**

The mission of Miami Edison Senior High School, in partnership with its stakeholders, is to provide students with a first class, globally focused education that enables graduates to be designers of their own destinies as successful future world citizens. Our goal is for all students enrolled at Miami Edison Senior High to achieve academic success, acquire marketable career skills and obtain post- secondary educational experiences.

Miami Edison Senior High School firmly believes that the collaborative efforts of students, parents, teachers, counselors, and administrators will lead to a community of critical and compassionate learners who will embrace their diversity and work as one. In order to achieve these goals, all students must adhere to the following expectations.

- 2.0 Minimum (“C” grade point average), in all subject areas, with particular attention to English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies.
- 2.0 Minimum (“C” grade point average), in conduct.
- Students cannot fall below a grade of “C” in their academics each nine weeks or fall below a grade “C” in conduct each nine weeks.
- Must abide by School Board Attendance Rule 6GX13-5A-1.04. No more than five (5) absences per semester course. No more than ten (10) absences per year.
- All students must wear the school uniform at all times.
- Students must complete the community service project required by Miami-Dade County Public Schools stated in the Pupil Progression Plan and in their respective academies.
- All students are expected to demonstrate honesty and integrity by following the Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) Code of Student Conduct, (Board Rule 6Gx13-5D-1.081).

In individual cases where it may appear that improvement is needed, a review committee comprised of the student, teachers, counselor, and a supervising administrator will examine each student’s record. The parent, teacher, counselor and student will collaborate to develop strategies that will outline assistance for each student in achieving his/her maximum level of performance.

A student may be placed on probation if he or she does not meet the above mentioned requirements and/or expectations. The probation process is as follows:

- *Probation Warning.* The student and parent will receive written notification, informing them that the student has not demonstrated the behaviors necessary for success in the academy.
- *Probation.* During the nine week grading period immediately following the above warning, the student must show sufficient progress he/she will be unable to participate in extracurricular and/or athletic activities.
- *Probation Conference.* A meeting will be held with the student, parent, lead teacher and counselor recommending alternative plans for the student (i.e. required tutoring, counseling, etc).
- *Exit Conference.* If the grade point average of an outside boundary magnet student falls below a 2.0, or the student fails to meet attendance and/or conduct requirements and expectations, a final conference will be held and the student will be exited to his/her home school.
