What will PBS look like in our school?

- **Data** will be used to help track progress and identify areas to target for intervention
- Discipline referral **Processes & Procedures** will be **Consistent** throughout the school
- The school will develop and use school-wide **Expectations & Rules** in settings across campus to **Teach** students appropriate behavior
- A **Reward System** will be used to encourage and model appropriate behavior and **Effective Consequences** will be developed and used to discourage inappropriate behavior.



School-wide PBS

- A **collaborative**, assessment-based process to developing effective interventions for problem behavior
- Emphasizes the use of **proactive, educative, and reinforcement-based** strategies to achieve meaningful and durable behavior and lifestyle outcomes
- Aim is to build **functional**, effective environments in which appropriate behavior is more effective than problem behavior

Greetings! The Miami Edison Senior High School PBS team is proud to announce our second year of school-wide Positive Behavior Support (PBS). Both teachers and administrators at Miami Edison Senior High School will continue to implement this yearlong program which is designed to teach students about self-awareness, communication, and problem solving strategies. Our school will actively participate in implementing this program through a Tiered intervention model in both group and individual participation to educate our students on how to achieve positive performance results which can lead to improved academic results. We will be using the following acronym, 3R's, to present these expectations to all students. The letters in the acronym stand for **Respectful, Reliable, and Responsible**.

The students at Miami Edison Senior High School began learning about school-wide behavioral expectations during the 2011-2012 school year. These expectations have been decided upon by the staff as an effective way to proactively manage behaviors in the classroom and throughout the school. The following information illustrates the expectation including what the particular behaviors should look like at the high school level.

Respectful	Showing a feeling or attitude of admiration toward self and others
Reliable	Being able to be trusted to do what is expected or promised
Responsible	Accountable to self and others

A monthly PBS calendar will be posted throughout our school announcing the various PBS activities in which both our students and faculty members will participate in. Students will also receive a copy of the calendar each month to share with parents/guardians. Students will receive individual recognition for their efforts in achieving school wide success by having their names and individual accomplishments announced over the PA system in addition to participating in our monthly PBS recognition events.

Please take this opportunity to discuss with your child (ren) the importance of the anticipated outcome of the PBS program and how it will assist him or her to become a successful and responsible individual. With your support and involvement, students will continue to strive toward reaching individual academic learning goals, and continue to promote school wide positive Raider 3R behaviors.
